1. Date and Location

a. This administrative selection board, consisting of you as president and the members listed in enclosure (1), is ordered to convene at Navy Personnel Command, Millington, TN, at 0800, 19 June 2014, or as soon as practicable thereafter.

b. The board shall proceed in accordance with all guidance in this letter and the FY-15 Administrative Selection Board Precept, reference (a).

2. Function. The function of the board is to recommend:

a. Officers in the Supply Corps (3100) community, Promotion Year Group (PYG) 13 for Commander Operational;

b. Officers in the Supply Corps (3100) community, PYG-13, for Commander Command Ashore;

c. Officers in the Supply Corps (3100) community, PYG-14, for Commander Operational;

d. Commanders and commander (selects) in the Supply Corps Full Time Support (FTS) (3107) community for Commander Command Ashore;

e. Review the performance of previously selected officers in the Commander Operational bank and Command Ashore Qualified Insufficient Opportunity (QIO) list, and recommend for removal, if warranted.

3. Board Authorized Selections

a. The total number of candidates that may be recommended in each competitive category is listed below:

Supply Corps (3100/3107) Commander Selection Goals (Note 1):

<u>Category</u>	<u>Selection Goal</u>
PYG-13 (Operational)	3
PYG-13 (Command Ashore)	1
PYG-14 (Operational)	7
FTS (Command Ashore)	1
Operational/Command Ashore Bank	Reaffirm

* **Note (1):** Supply Corps officers (3100) selected "Operational" will fill Commander Operational assignments at the earliest opportunity, based on career progression, seniority, and available billets. Officers selected "Operational" are qualified, via this board, to serve in Command Ashore billets before or after their primary "Operational" assignment. Officers selected "Command Ashore" will serve in Command Ashore billets at the earliest opportunity, based on career progression, seniority, and available billets.

b. Special Requirements:

(1) Select to the skill set in paragraph 3.b.(2) below to the maximum extent possible. If the skill set selection goal cannot be met, you should still attempt to select to the total overall selection goals as outlined in paragraph 3.a. above.

(2) There are no commands rolling in 2015 with special skill requirements (e.g. contracting, fuels, etc).

c. Qualified/Insufficient Opportunity (QIO) for Command Ashore: In the Commander Command Ashore screens (3100/3107), there will be officers who will not be selected for command because of limited opportunity, but whose record clearly meets selection criteria. The board should identify such officers to the Recorder for annotation in the Recorder's ledger. Those officers will be promulgated in the Post Board Report and maintained for three years. Should a need arise during the CY 2015, 2016, or 2017 detailing cycle for an additional officer to fill a screen-required assignment, an officer identified as QIO shall be considered qualified and additional administrative procedures need not be pursued. There is no limit to the number

selected for QIO. All officers with records worthy of command, but not selected, should be placed on the QIO list.

4. Additional Guidance. The below information is provided to clarify community requirements and any specific needs, but in no way should replace the Best and Fully Qualified Standard of reference (a).


a. Operational Bank/Command Ashore QIO Review. To ensure standards of performance are maintained, the records of officers previously selected for Commander Operational/Command Ashore, but not yet in their tour, shall be reviewed. This review should only be a review of the member's record since the last review. Those officers whose records, since Operational Bank/Command Ashore QIO selection, in the opinion of a majority of the board members, indicate significant decline in performance, or which contain material subsequent to the last board which casts doubt upon their qualifications to serve as a Commander in an Operational or Command Ashore assignment, shall be reported. This report shall include a recommendation regarding removal from the Commander Operational Bank/Command Ashore QIO list, as appropriate. The purpose of this review is to ensure continuing quality of officers selected for Operational and Command Ashore assignments.

b. The specified goals are designed to provide an equitable overall percentage selection rate for each PYG.

c. Only those officers who comply with reference (b), fulfilling command qualification requirements, will be eligible for consideration. The final actual eligible numbers will be determined as of the date the board convenes.

d. Officers who submit written or emailed requests to not have their record considered for the screen will be ineligible and their record will not be screened.

e. Officers with approved retirement or separation orders, and officers whose retirement or separation requests have been received by PERS-8, will be ineligible and their record will not be screened.
